

Options

**Valerie Ontology:** a vocabulary of professional and scientific terms and synonyms in 7 languages – selected themes

- more thematic domains ('dairy', 'SmartFarming'....)
- more EU languages
- Improve structure
  - differentiate types of relations between terms
  - elaborate "problem solution relations": innovation
  - .....
- Integration with other vocabularies / thesauri
- Explore automated processes to expand ontology / 'big data'
- Role for community to expand vocabulary



# Future Options

#### **Search functionality:**

- Auto-completion of query
- Query enhancement by Query Editor
- Language selection (preferred / 'can read')
- Selection and ranking of docs
- Presentation of retrieved docs & Snippets

#### **Pre-processing:**

- Automated Annotation of docs obtained
- Ranking
- Snippet identification

#### **User-Community features**

- engagement with other practitioners
- document sharing via social media
- contribute to ask-Valerie.eu document base & ontology

- User restrict/choose collections (by category; by name)
- Improved versions of algorithms (collect user feedback)
- User can create **personal** archive
- Operational Groups as communities
- Advisers present themselves
  their expertise
- Harvest 'user-liked' docs found by other search engines
- More prominent place for issue-solution pairs / strings: interactive guide to innovations







#### **Future roles of advisory services:**

- Farmers need the <u>right form</u> of <u>affordable farm advice</u> more urgent than ever
- Production system oriented (technological) advice is lacking
- New role for agricultural support : <u>impartial\* and farm-tailored</u> advice
- Reconnection of advisors within the AKIS is vital
- From a linear role to a <u>listening and coaching</u> role
- Facilitate <u>peer-to-peer</u> processes
- Increasing possibilities for <u>online and automated advice</u> necessitate stepping up <u>advisory competences and tools</u> enabling the <u>multiple use of data</u>

## **Policy Brief SCAR SWG AKIS4**



- Key is to enable advisory services with hard and soft infrastructure for enhancing knowledge flows
- Develop approaches making knowledge generated with public funds better utilized and shared
- There is a need for a reliable, qualitative information platform of user-oriented information enhancing and creating more interactiveness
- Install a reliable platform oriented to empowering end-users, creating enhanced interactiveness and knowledge flows
- Need for 'interactive wiki'


